The main residence: Recently a major renovation was carried out to enlarge this cottage. It now features a modern kitchen with dining area, light and airy lounge room, 2 bedrooms, one with walk in robe, central bathroom and verandah on two sides. Enjoy your morning cuppa whilst watching the stunning sunrises and magical valley views.

Three Cottages: Each cottage has two bedrooms, one bathroom, kitchen/dining/lounge, undercover deck, separately metered electricity, phone line and a 500 gal water tank for fresh drinking water.

Outdoors: High capacity bio-cycle sewerage system, 3 x 5,000 gallon water tanks, spring fed dam, two 8 x 5 metre sheds connected by 8 x 6 metre undercover area and a separate laundry. Also, the bridle trails take you through some beautiful bushland with abundant wildlife.

Other Features: Electricity and phone are connected. All cottages face East North East. Zone 1C.
