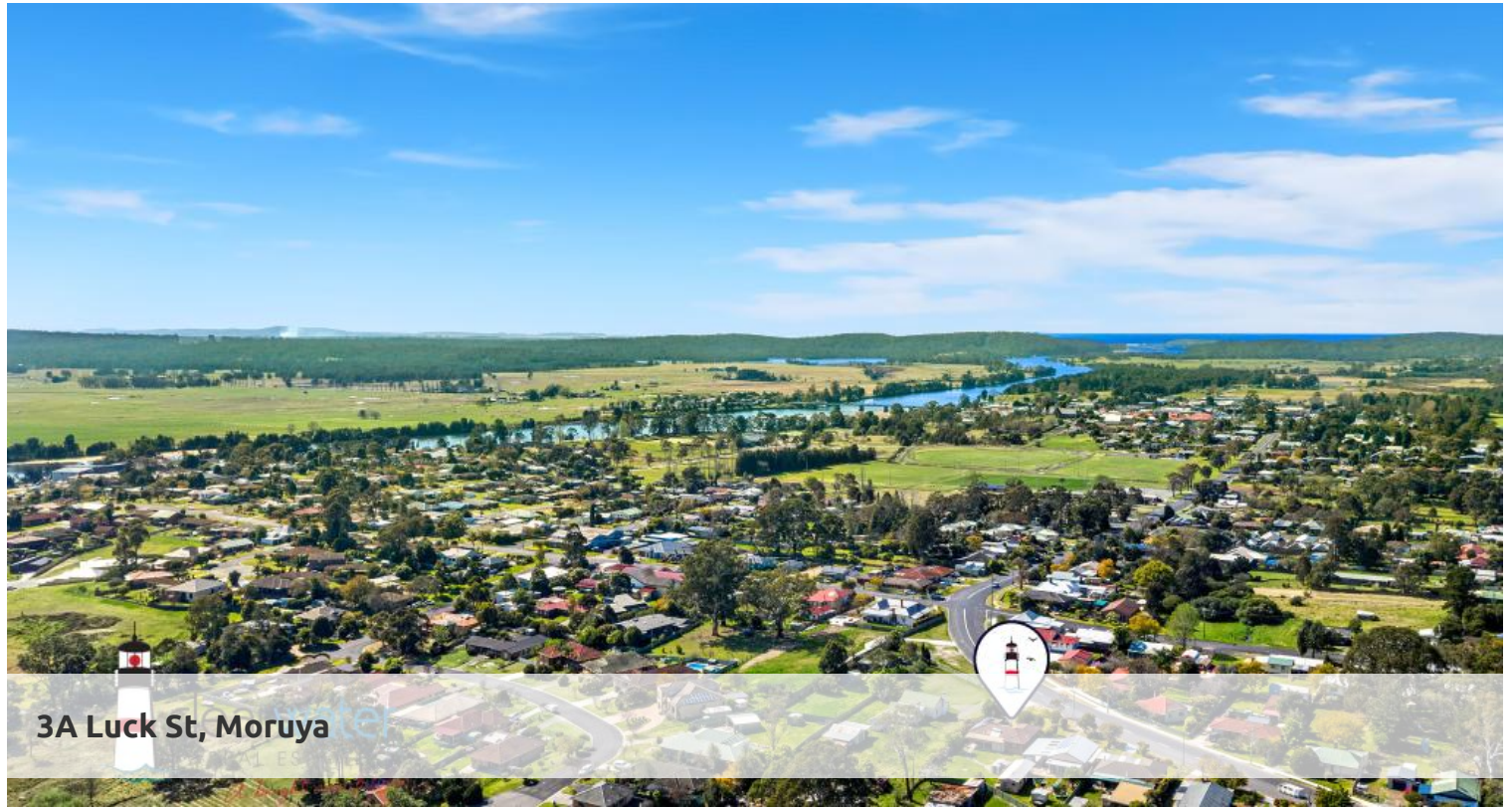




For Rent - Single Level Family Home in Moruya
